As previously announced Eastman Kodak Company has discontinued manufacturing of all Eastman Ektachrome Color Reversal Motion Picture Films (Process VNF).

Kodak will manufacture its 'last batch' of VNF chemicals on October 1, 2006. We will pull all existing inventory prior to the release of our 'last batch' as a means of delivering product consistency. This will ensure consistent expiration dates and time stamping of all VNF components within the supply chain as we move forward.

This letter serves as reminder to place your orders for VNF chemical stock in October. Your ability to forecast and purchase the desired quantities of photoprocessing materials will help us manage the exit from this business. Finally, we want to assure you that through this final transition your photoprocessing needs will be met.
