- KODAK DRYVIEW Laser Imaging Film must often be separated from traditional x-ray or other film types before processing in order to recycle silver and polyester base. Customers may be able to save money on film recycling by keeping paper envelopes and papers separate from film, and DRYVIEW Laser Imaging Film separate from other film types. Unlike traditional x-ray film, DRYVIEW Laser Imaging Film has a small, laser-printed identification # at the margin. Check with your scrap handler regarding separation.
