



Instructions

- 1. Print this PDF on regular printer paper (photo paper is not a good option).
- 2. Select one each of the brows, eyes, nose and mouth. Cut and paste them onto the blank template at the designated areas.
- 3. Place the pattern created by this template a clean pumpkin. Choose the flattest side of the pumpkin to apply the pattern to carve.
- 4. Tape or pin your pattern onto your pumpkin (make sure the surface is dry so the tape will stick!). Use a pumpkin poking tool, awl, or nail to poke small, shallow holes through the paper, following the lines of the pattern. When you apply the pattern, poke the holes about ¼" apart. When all lines have been traced, remove pattern and save it for reference later.
 - HINT: If you're having trouble viewing your poked out pattern, rub a little flour, cornstarch or baby powder into the dots. The dots will turn bright white and your design will practically pop off the pumpkin!
- 5. Carve out the pattern using the printed template as a guide.

These are the eyebrows for your pumpkin. Choose one set, cut and apply to the blank pumpkin template (as shown below). Carve only the black.






PUMPKIN FACE!

These are the noses for your pumpkin. Choose one set, cut and apply to the blank pumpkin template (as shown below). Carve only the black.






















MAKE YOUR OWN

These are the mouths for your pumpkin. Choose one set, cut and apply to the blank pumpkin template (as shown below). Carve only the black.

Mouths get placed below the nose.
